❖ Affiliation Fees (Lindenow, Heyfield, Sale & Bairnsdale Golf Bowls Club.)

The said Clubs had their say on what their problem with Bowls Vic was, however let's hope that it is now all behind us.

Membership database:

Club databases can now be linked to the Bowls Victoria database. By choosing to utilise this element all changes to your database will automatically be replicated with Bowls Victoria – therefore there would be <u>no need to fill in a BV4 for a new player</u>, <u>no need to fill in a BV6 for a Change of details and no need to supply a club membership list at the start of a season.</u>

Clubs are reminded that they ARE NOT to add a new member to their database that is transferring in from another Club nor delete anybody who is transferring out.

The clearance process within the system will do this for you.

Clubs are also reminded that they **ARE NOT** to delete members from their Club listing, especially people who are likely to transfer out of the Club.

All you are required to do is make the member inactive.

Region Pennant Finals (Sale Bowls Club)

Bowls Vic hands are tied when it comes to the fining of Club/s, for the non participation of the Pennant Finals (because it is classed as another Tournament)

it is a sad state of affairs when Clubs do not follow through with their obligations.

However they did say that they should be ashamed of what they have done (Sale) and in the future makes sure it does not happen again.
