♣ New Bowls Victoria Logo:

Clubs do not need new shirts, both Logo's are acceptable. Clothing Manufactures/shops still have to sell existing stock. (An explanation has been sent out to all Clubs to relay to their members.)

♣ Mobile Phones:

are to be switched off during Pennant and above, if a player is waiting on an urgent phone call then they must give the phone to the Umpire.

E.G.B.D. Midweek Pennant Survey was commented upon, stating that it was by choice if bowlers did not want to play Midweek Pennant and that it was their loss.

♣ Winter Pennant:

Clubs in Victoria have instigated Winter Pennant and stated that it was very successful. (Great idea?)

• <u>Uniforms for Pennant</u>: If Clubs have registered with Bowls Vic their club shirts/ trousers etc, then those colours can be worn in Pennant, (navy, black, white etc.)
However if Clubs only registered their tops with Bowls Vic. then bowlers may choose what colour they wear as long as it has the Bowls Logo on the trousers etc. (With Club approval)

1.3 HEADWEAR:

White, Coloured or Registered Club coloured headwear may be worn.

Such headwear, in all <u>Pennant and above Competitions</u> must have the Bowls Australia logo. <u>White block hats with club hatband maybe worn (no logo required).</u>

Headwear is always optional, however Bowls Victoria recommends all Members protect themselves from the elements at all times.
